Where to file

State

Oklahoma registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Sales are permitted on site, by delivery, at farmers markets, through cooperatives, and through membership-based buying clubs. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry may promulgate rules to allow sales at other locations or by other means. County ordinances may regulate but may not conflict with or impede the Act. For TCS foods, the producer must complete an approved food safety training (e.g., ServSafe Food Handler Training, max 8 hours, available online) before selling.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. No specific Comanche County home occupation permit requirements found for cottage food. Oklahoma state law does not require local permits. Lawton city or Comanche County unincorporated zoning may have home occupation requirements. Contact Comanche County planning or Lawton city planning for local zoning specifics.

Health

No. Oklahoma Homemade Food Freedom Act does not require inspections. Complaint-driven investigation by OSDH possible.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Oklahoma allows broad sales channels including direct sales, online, and limited indirect channels. Alcoholic beverages, unpasteurized milk, and cannabis products prohibited. Annual cap is \$75,000.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

A commissary is a food-service license, not Food Freedom. Oklahoma Homemade Food Freedom is a home path. A commissary is a food establishment licensed by the State Department of Health.
