Where to file

State

Oklahoma registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Sales are permitted on site, by delivery, at farmers markets, through cooperatives, and through membership-based buying clubs. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry may promulgate rules to allow sales at other locations or by other means. County ordinances may regulate but may not conflict with or impede the Act. For TCS foods, the producer must complete an approved food safety training (e.g., ServSafe Food Handler Training, max 8 hours, available online) before selling.

Varies. Garfield County includes Enid in north-central Oklahoma. No specific county home occupation permit for cottage food identified. Local zoning in Enid may apply. Contact Garfield County Planning or City of Enid Planning at (580) 249-6950.

Pickup / delivery

Broad: any channel including internet, farmers markets, events, home, retail stores. Indirect sales of non-TCS products permitted. TCS products must be sold direct to informed end consumer by producer or designated agent.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

A commissary is a food-service license, not Food Freedom. Oklahoma Homemade Food Freedom is a home path. A commissary is a food establishment licensed by the State Department of Health.
