Where to file

State

Oklahoma registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Sales are permitted on site, by delivery, at farmers markets, through cooperatives, and through membership-based buying clubs. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry may promulgate rules to allow sales at other locations or by other means. County ordinances may regulate but may not conflict with or impede the Act. For TCS foods, the producer must complete an approved food safety training (e.g., ServSafe Food Handler Training, max 8 hours, available online) before selling.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. City of Tulsa may have home occupation permit requirements for home-based businesses. Contact Tulsa Planning Office for home occupation or accessory use provisions. Tulsa County governs unincorporated areas. State food freedom law does not address local zoning preemption for home occupation purposes.

Oklahoma Homemade Food Freedom Act: broad direct and limited indirect sales. Online, events, home sales permitted. \$75,000 annual cap.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

A commissary is a food-service license, not Food Freedom. Oklahoma Homemade Food Freedom is a home path. A commissary is a food establishment licensed by the State Department of Health.
