Benton County, Oregon. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Oregon registration: Depends. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Direct sales to end users are permitted in any manner including online, mail, and at events. Sales to retailers (including coffee shops but not restaurants) are permitted if the retailer agrees to store/display the foods separately and clearly indicate they are homemade and not prepared in an inspected food establishment. Sales to institutions (restaurants, schools, hospitals, caterers, day care centers, nursing homes, correctional facilities) are prohibited. A Domestic Kitchen Bakery License (~\$50/year) is required for establishments wishing to sell to retailers under licensed status rather than using the residential-dwelling exemption. The department may provide a unique identification number for use on labels. Annual records must be maintained for 3 years.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Benton County (Corvallis) has a university community (Oregon State University). No Benton County-specific cottage food permit identified. Operators should check with Benton County Planning or City of Corvallis for home-based business rules.

Health

No. No routine inspection for residential dwelling establishments under ORS §616.723.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Direct-to-consumer sales from home, online, mail, and events all permitted (SB 643, 2023 expanded from prior event-only restriction). Sales to retailers permitted under specific conditions. Cannot sell to institutions (restaurants, schools, hospitals, nursing homes). No internet/mail order restrictions stated post-SB 643.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

ODA licenses food establishments. Oregon residential-dwelling exemption is a home path. A commissary or licensed domestic kitchen bakery is an ODA food establishment.
