This is what it takes to sell from a home kitchen in Lane County. Confirm each step with Planning, Health, and the license office before you sell.

Lane County, Oregon. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Oregon registration: Depends. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Direct sales to end users are permitted in any manner including online, mail, and at events. Sales to retailers (including coffee shops but not restaurants) are permitted if the retailer agrees to store/display the foods separately and clearly indicate they are homemade and not prepared in an inspected food establishment. Sales to institutions (restaurants, schools, hospitals, caterers, day care centers, nursing homes, correctional facilities) are prohibited. A Domestic Kitchen Bakery License (~\$50/year) is required for establishments wishing to sell to retailers under licensed status rather than using the residential-dwelling exemption. The department may provide a unique identification number for use on labels. Annual records must be maintained for 3 years.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Lane County has home occupation provisions in its zoning code. Unincorporated areas require county compliance. Incorporated areas (Eugene, Springfield, etc.) have their own zoning requirements. Oregon cottage food law does not preempt local zoning; operators should verify with Lane County Planning or local municipality.

Health

No. No routine inspection required under ORS §616.723.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Direct sales from home, online, mail, events. May also sell to retailers (Domestic Kitchen Bakery License ~\$50/year pathway). Cannot sell to institutions.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

ODA licenses food establishments. Oregon residential-dwelling exemption is a home path. A commissary or licensed domestic kitchen bakery is an ODA food establishment.
