Where to file

State

Pennsylvania registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: Yes. Registration includes sales direct from the production site including internet sales. However, a separate Retail Food Facility License may be required for sales at events or Farmers Markets. Businesses aiming to sell across state lines might also need FDA registration. The registration covers home-based operations in residential kitchens as well as residential-style kitchens in alternate locations such as churches, fire halls, or remodeled garages. Not available in Philadelphia County.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Lackawanna County and City of Scranton zoning may require a home occupation permit for food business operations from a residence. Contact Lackawanna County Planning Commission or Scranton City Planning for home occupation permit requirements. Applicants must also confirm zoning allows a food business at the residential address as part of the PA LFE application process.

Health

Yes. Initial on-site inspection required before registration is issued. Subsequent routine inspections apply under PA Department of Agriculture oversight.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Pennsylvania LFE program permits sales directly to consumers and through limited indirect channels (depending on product type). Home pickup, delivery, and farmers market sales permitted. Contact PA Department of Agriculture for specific product category restrictions.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

PDA Limited Food Establishment is still not a retail commissary. Pennsylvania Limited Food Establishment covers certain residential-style kitchens. A retail commissary or shared kitchen typically needs a Retail Food Facility license as well. Ask PDA and the local health department.
