Where to file

State

South Carolina registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Since the 2022 amendment, home-based food operations may sell to retail stores and grocery stores in addition to direct-to-consumer sales including online and mail order. Retail stores that sell home-based food products must post clearly visible signage indicating the products are not subject to commercial food regulations.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. Lancaster County may have local home occupation zoning requirements. No Lancaster County-specific cottage food permit identified. Operators should check with Lancaster County Planning.

Health

No. No inspection authority; the 2022 amendment removed the prior inspection exemption application process.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Direct and indirect sales allowed. Retail stores, grocery stores, online, mail order, farmers markets, home pickup all permitted as of 2022 amendment. No out-of-state restriction stated.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

DHEC licenses retail food. South Carolina home-based food production is a home path. A commissary is a retail food establishment licensed by DHEC.
