Where to file

State

Utah registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Registered cottage food operations may sell through various channels. The Utah Department of Agriculture and Food (UDAF) issues registration; local health departments do not have jurisdiction to regulate compliant cottage food operations except to investigate foodborne illness outbreaks. The state also has a separate Home Consumption and Homemade Food Act (Utah Code Title 4, Chapter 5A) that allows unregistered sales of certain homemade foods with a business license, but only at direct-to-sale farmers markets or direct-to-sale locations with appropriate signage. Food service establishments may not use cottage food products as ingredients in food served to the public.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. UDAF registration required. UDAF explicitly prohibits local health departments from regulating compliant cottage food operations. Tooele County may have local zoning home occupation requirements, but not food safety requirements. No Tooele County-specific cottage food ordinance found.

Health

No. No routine inspection. UDAF may investigate upon complaint. Local health departments have no jurisdiction over compliant registered operations.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Broad sales rights under the Cottage Food Registration: direct and indirect sales, online, farmers markets, home. Alternative Home Consumption pathway restricted to direct-to-sale farmers markets or direct-to-sale locations.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

UDAF cottage food is not a food-service permit. Utah cottage food is a UDAF registration. A commissary is a food establishment permitted by the local health department.
