Kitsap County, Washington. File every Yes. Confirm every Check or Ask. Stay under the sales cap.

Where to file

State

Washington registration: Yes. Routine kitchen inspection: Yes. Cottage food products may only be sold directly to the consumer. Internet sales, mail order, and retail sale outside Washington state are explicitly prohibited. Products may not be repackaged, sold, or used as an ingredient by a food processing plant, or sold by a food service establishment.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. WA does not preempt local zoning. Kitsap County (includes Port Orchard, Bremerton) may have home occupation zoning requirements at county or city level. Operator should verify with Kitsap County Planning or local city planning

Health

Yes. Initial kitchen inspection required before registration; complaint-based thereafter

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Direct to consumer only; farmers markets, events, roadside stands; no retail or wholesale

If you rent a commissary kitchen

Local health licenses food establishments. WSDA licenses cottage food. Washington cottage food is a WSDA permit for a home kitchen. A commissary is a food establishment permitted by the local health jurisdiction.
