## Where to file

### State

Wisconsin registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Home-canned goods must be sold at community or social events or farmers' markets in Wisconsin (§97.29(2)(b)2.b). The Kivirist court order applies to direct-to-consumer sales by home bakers. Products cannot be sold to retail food establishments or distributed through wholesale channels without a license.

### Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. Grant County may have township-level zoning that regulates home occupations. No specific county-level home occupation rules found in research. Incorporated municipalities within Grant County (Lancaster, Platteville area, etc.) have separate municipal codes. Recommend verifying with Grant County Planning/Zoning.

### Health

No. No inspection for qualifying cottage food bakers. DATCP may not enforce licensing requirements against qualifying home bakers per Kivirist order.

### Business license

Varies

### Pickup / delivery

Direct-to-consumer sales only for exempt operations. Pickle Bill limits sales to community events and farmers markets for home-canned goods. Kivirist exception bakers may sell at home, markets, and events.

### If you rent a commissary kitchen

**DATCP licenses food processing; local health licenses restaurants.** Wisconsin unlicensed home baking is a narrow path. A commissary is typically a DATCP food processing plant or a local food-service license. Ask the kitchen which license they hold.
