Where to file

State

Wisconsin registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Home-canned goods must be sold at community or social events or farmers' markets in Wisconsin (§97.29(2)(b)2.b). The Kivist court order applies to direct-to-consumer sales by home bakers. Products cannot be sold to retail food establishments or distributed through wholesale channels without a license.

Zoning / home occupation

Varies. No specific Sheboygan County home occupation permit requirements found for cottage food. Local zoning (county unincorporated and city of Sheboygan) may have home occupation requirements. Contact Sheboygan County Planning or city of Sheboygan zoning.

Health

No. No routine inspection required under Kivist/Pickle Bill. Complaint-driven investigation possible.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Wisconsin: direct sales only. Pickle Bill: community events and farmers markets only. Kivist: direct consumer sales at low volume. No wholesale or retail.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

DATCP licenses food processing; local health licenses restaurants. Wisconsin unlicensed home baking is a narrow path. A commissary is typically a DATCP food processing plant or a local food-service license. Ask the kitchen which license they hold.
