Where to file

State

Wyoming registration: No. Routine kitchen inspection: No. Wyoming's Food Freedom Act allows considerably broader indirect sales than most states. Non-potentially hazardous foods, eggs, and dairy products may be sold through third-party vendors (retail shops, grocery stores) as long as the sale complies with the Act. The third-party seller must inform consumers that the food is not certified, licensed, or inspected, and non-potentially hazardous foods must be displayed separately from licensed products with a label stating 'this food was made in a home kitchen, is not regulated or inspected and may contain allergens.' Potentially hazardous homemade foods (except eggs/dairy) must be sold by the producer or designated agent only. A 'designated agent' may also facilitate transactions including marketing, transport, storage, and delivery without taking ownership of the product.

Zoning / home occupation

Conditional. State Food Freedom Act (§11-49-103) exempts cottage food from state licensure, permitting, and inspection. However, Natrona County has a Home Occupation Permit requirement for home-based businesses, and the City of Casper may require zoning compliance. Producers should verify with Natrona County and City of Casper Community Development for any home occupation permit requirements. No specific cottage food exemption from local zoning found.

Health

No. No routine inspection. Wyoming Dept. of Agriculture may investigate upon illness complaint.

Business license

Varies

Pickup / delivery

Sales may occur at farmers markets, farms, ranches, producer's homes or offices, retail locations of third-party sellers (for non-TCS foods, eggs, and dairy), or any agreed location. Producer must inform end consumer that food is not certified, labeled, licensed, packaged, regulated, or inspected.

If you rent a commissary kitchen

Food Freedom is a home path. A commissary is a food establishment. Wyoming Food Freedom covers homemade food sold under that Act. A commissary used as a food establishment is licensed by the local health department.
