Illinois labeling notes

Statute: 410 ILCS 625/4 (Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act, §4)

Font requirement: (none specified)

Required disclaimer: This product was produced in a home kitchen not inspected by a health department that may also process common food allergens.

Summary: Labels must include the product name, ingredients in descending order by weight, allergen information, net weight/volume, the city/unit of local government name, and the point-of-sale notice: 'This product was produced in a home kitchen not inspected by a health department that may also process common food allergens.' Products must be pre-packaged in the home kitchen; exceptions (e.g., wedding cakes) require local health department approval.
