How to use this template

Replace product name, business name, address, ingredients, and net weight for each SKU. Keep allergen statements in plain English. Do not paraphrase required disclaimer language when the state mandates exact wording.

Minnesota labeling notes

Statute: Minn. Stat. §28A.152

Font requirement: (none specified)

Required disclaimer: These products are homemade and not subject to state inspection.

Summary: Labels must accurately reflect: the name and registration number or address of the producer; the date on which the food was prepared; ingredients and any possible allergens; and the statement 'These products are homemade and not subject to state inspection.' At farmers markets and community events, a visible placard with the same statement must be displayed. Online sellers must display the statement on their website. Registration number may substitute for home address.
