How to use this template

Replace product name, business name, address, ingredients, and net weight for each SKU. Keep allergen statements in plain English. Do not paraphrase required disclaimer language when the state mandates exact wording.

Montana labeling notes

Statute: Mont. Code §50-50-116 and §50-50-117 (cottage food); Mont. Code §§50-49-201 et seq. (Local Food Choice Act)

Font requirement: 11-point

Required disclaimer: Made in a home kitchen that is not subject to retail food establishment regulations or inspections.

Summary: Labels must include: name, address, city, state, zip of operation; product name; ingredients in descending order by weight; net quantity; allergen labeling per federal/state law; and a conspicuous statement in at least 11-point font: 'Made in a home kitchen that is not subject to retail food establishment regulations or inspections.' Under the MLFCA, producers must inform consumers that the food has not been licensed, permitted, certified, packaged, labeled, or inspected.
