North Dakota labeling notes

Statute: N.D. Cent. Code §23-09.5-01 through §23-09.5-02

Font requirement: (none specified)

Required disclaimer: This product is made in a home kitchen that is not inspected by the state or local health department.

Summary: No formal labeling is required for non-refrigerated products, but the operator must inform the consumer verbally or in writing that the product is not certified, labeled, licensed, packaged, regulated, or inspected. Refrigerated items (cream-filled baked goods, cheesecake, pumpkin pie, cream cheese items) must carry safe handling instructions and a statement that the product was transported and maintained frozen. All products must have either a sign at point of sale or a label stating: 'This product is made in a home kitchen that is not inspected by the state or local health department.'
